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### **Community**

Hilliard is a suburban, residential community located northwest of Columbus, Ohio. The District encompasses approximately 60 square miles which includes portions of the City of Columbus, the City of Dublin and five surrounding townships. The community is one of the fastest-growing in the state of Ohio with over 96,000 residents and over 16,300 school students. The district celebrates diversity through its current rapid growth.

### **School**

Hilliard Online Academy is a four-year comprehensive public school of 79 students. School is in session 176 days a year. The academic year is divided into two semesters with four nine-week grading periods. Students navigate through their courses asynchronously with support of their teacher.

### **Faculty**

Hilliard Online Academy has 17 certificated professional staff. Of the certificated staff, 16 have earned advanced degrees.

### **Graduation Requirements**

Hilliard Online Academy is a comprehensive high school that includes college preparatory, honors, Advanced Placement, dual enrollment, occupational, vocational and adjustment programs. Students must meet the following requirements to graduate: Demonstrate competency on the Algebra I and English Language Arts II state test (or through alternative demonstrations), demonstrate readiness for post-high school by earning two seals including a state defined seal, and complete 21.5 credits that include:

English - 4 credits	Mathematics - 4 credits (must include Alg. 2 or equivalent)
US Government - 1 credit	Science - 3 credits (1 credit Biology; 1 credit Phys. Sci.)
US History - 1 credit	Health - .5 credit
World Studies - 1 credit	Physical Education - .5 credits
Financial Literacy Elective - .5 credit	Digital Connections/Future Ready - .5 credit
Senior Capstone - .5 credit	Additional Electives - 5 credits

### **Advanced Placement and Honors**

### **College Credit Plus**
