Notes from the Nurse

Welcome to Weaver 2024-2025! Our clinic staff for this year includes me, Heide Stoessner, and Abby Gischel, our returning clinic aide. I am new to the Weaver and Davidson buildings this year. I have been a Hilliard district nurse for 16 years in our elementary buildings, most recently at Britton and Norwich. I am very excited to be joining the staff at Weaver and I'm looking forward to reconnecting with some of my former students! If your student has prescription medication that they will carry or store in the clinic, there must be a completed medication form to accompany each medication. You can access the forms on the district website under the medical forms at this link: https://www.hilliardschools.org/news/forms/. Each medication will need form "A" (Parent permission) *plus* either form "B" "C" or "D" (Prescriber Authorization) depending on the type of medication. These forms are universal throughout the school district, however, newly signed and completely forms are required each new school year. You can also pick one up from the school if you prefer.

Starting in 7th grade, students may carry a day's worth of Over-the-Counter medications with them. It needs to be in the original bottle and have Form "A", the parent authorization form signed and turned in to the clinic.

If your student has had any changes in their medical history, please contact me. In addition, ff your student calls or texts you saying they don't feel well during the school day and wants to be picked up, please encourage them to come to the clinic so we can help with that process. By coming to the clinic, we can assess their condition and then collaborate with you on the next steps.

I hope this year is a good one for you and your student! Let me know if I can be of any help.

School Starts Soon!

As the days of Summer wind down, there are plenty of things our families can do now to prepare for the first day of school on Wednesday, August 21! Remember, on the first day to share first day pictures on social media with #HCSD1. Let's share all the fun all day long!

If you haven't already, you should soon begin receiving emails and newsletters from your student's school. All back to school information, including welcome days, supply lists, and more, can be found the school web page. (You can find a link to your school off the district web page, www.HilliardSchools.org)

Now is the time to update the following items to ensure a smooth transition into the year:

- 1. In Home Access Center:
 - a. Update your student's Enrollment/Registration Information Be sure we have your updated contact information in Home Access Center. It is especially important we have an accurate MAIN/PRIMARY phone number listed as well as an email address. These pieces of contact information are used by the district and your child's school building for emergency and important notification messages.
 - b. Sign-off on Student Handbook and iPad Loan Agreement
 - c. Submit a Change of Address request form as soon as possible if you have moved.

Free/Reduced Lunch Information

The 2024-2025 school year Free/Reduced Lunch Benefit guidelines for students unable to pay the full price of meals served under the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Program are now available. To apply, households will need to complete an application. This can be done either online https://frapps.horizonsolana.com/hilc04 or complete a printed application and return it to the school. Copies can be printed from the Hilliard City School website or are available in the office in each school.

The State of Ohio Budget for school year 2024-2025 includes funding to cover the cost of reduced meals for breakfast and lunch. This provision allows schools to provide no cost meals to reduced price meal eligible students. Federal Income Eligibility Guidelines will be used to determine eligibility.

Guidelines from Aramark on Breakfast/Lunch in 2024/25

Some important reminders and information for students getting meals at school this year.

- After making their lunch or breakfast selections, students will enter their student ld numbers in pin pads and be processed by cashiers.
- Students who are eligible for free or reduced price meals will receive their meals free of charge.
- All other students must pay with cash or funds on their food service accounts.
- Parents are encouraged to deposit money in their child's food service accounts to speed up serving lines.

For students who do not qualify for free or reduced meals, elementary lunches will cost \$2.50. Secondary school lunches start at \$3.00. Breakfast is still a great bargain at \$1.25! If your child hasn't tried breakfast in school, we encourage them to do so. A hungry student is a distracted student. Starting the day with a nutritious breakfast is the best way to prepare students for the learning environment. So please take advantage of this opportunity to help your child start the day off on the right foot.
