However, we want to remind everyone that football games are schoolsponsored events, and all students are expected to behave appropriately.

Please take a moment to speak with your student about the importance of following appropriate behaviors during the game. If a student acts inappropriately, they will be asked to leave the event, and you will need to pick them up immediately. This is for their safety as well as for the enjoyment of all fans attending the game.

We want our students to come to the games, and be a part of our school community, we just ask for your partnership in ensuring that everyone can enjoy the games without disruption.

# **Preparing for the 8th Grade Washington DC Trip:**

<u>Parent-Student Meeting: Thursday, September 19<sup>th</sup> at 7:00 pm in the Main</u> <u>Gym.</u> Students who are going to DC have been added to a DC Canvas course. Parents, please remind them to accept that course invitation. Once they accept the invitation, parents will be enrolled as observers. From this course, they need to download the DC Behavior Contract and the Overnight Trip Medical Permission Form in Notability. Parents should complete both documents on their child's iPad. Students must then upload the completed documents to the assignments in Canvas. Forms are due no later than September 19th.

### Water Only in Classrooms/Hallways

# **Mobile Dentist is Coming to WMS September 19!**

Great news! Our school has partnered with Smile Programs, the mobile dentist, to offer in-school dental care on Thursday, September 19<sup>th</sup>, 2024. The mobile dentists will be set up at Weaver Middle School. Davidson students will be walked to and from Weaver by a Hilliard City Schools staff member at their appointment time. Sign up your child <u>here</u> or fill out a paper form (forms were delivered to students earlier this week). Please return any paper forms to the building nurse by September 16<sup>th</sup>, 2024. Even better, dental care is usually at no cost to you. All insurance is accepted including Medicaid and CHIP. For those without insurance, a low-cost self-pay option

is available. Our in-school dental program saves you time and provides a safe and comfortable place for your child to receive gentle dental care from licensed local professionals. Dental care includes a complete dental exam, x-rays, cleaning, fluoride and sealants when necessary, and in some cases, restorative care such as fillings.

#### **Picture Make-up/Retake Day – September 26**

Picture Make-up/Retake day will be the morning of Thursday, September 26<sup>th</sup> for students who missed picture day or who need to have a picture retake. If you missed ordering pictures on picture day, you can go to <u>shop.hrimaging.com</u> to order a picture package.

#### **General School Reminders:**

- To sign out your student early for an appointment or early dismissal, you will need to scan your Driver's License or state-issued ID using our School Safe ID kiosk in the main office, so please plan to **bring your ID into the office with you when you arrive.**
- All visitors and volunteers to our school (during the school day) will also be required to check in at our School Safe ID kiosk in the main office using a driver's license or state-issued ID.
- Just a reminder that students are permitted to have phones at school, however, they are not to be used during class time. Students are able to use them during their lunch period. Thank you for helping us to reinforce the expectations.

- At this time, we will <u>not</u> be allowing extra students on the bus. Only students assigned to the bus may ride.
- Students are <u>not</u> permitted to get food deliveries from any restaurant or delivery service (Grub Hub, Door Dash, etc.) during their lunch periods. Parents are permitted to drop off lunches for students in the main office.
- For continued safety in the car line, please stay in your lane when picking up your child do not pass any cars in front of you. There are too many vehicles in motion, as well as students walking, and we do not want any unsafe situations.
