## **General School Reminders:**

- To sign out your student early for an appointment or early dismissal, you will need to scan your Driver's License or state-issued ID using our School Safe ID kiosk in the main office, so please plan to bring your ID into the office with you when you arrive.
- All visitors and volunteers to our school (during the school day) will also be required to check in at our School Safe ID kiosk in the main office using a driver's license or state-issued ID.

- At this time, we will <u>not</u> be allowing extra students on the bus. Only students assigned to the bus may ride.
- Students are <u>not</u> permitted to get food deliveries from any restaurant or delivery service (Grub Hub, Door Dash, etc.) during their lunch periods. Parents are permitted to drop off lunches for students in the main office.
- For continued safety in the car line, please stay in your lane when
  picking up your child do not pass any cars in front of you. There are
  too many vehicles in motion, as well as students walking, and we do
  not want any unsafe situations.
- To avoid spills and keep our building clean, we ask that students only have water in our academic spaces.

## **Technology Privacy Notice**

This serves as Hilliard City School's annual technology privacy notice consistent with Ohio Revised Code Sections 3319.325 - .327.

General Monitoring of School-Issued Devices - Please be aware that the District, either directly or through a technology provider, is electing to generally monitor all school-issued devices (as that term is defined by O.R.C. 3319.325). The District generally monitors these features for the noncommercial education purpose of instruction, technical support, and/or exam proctoring. Additionally, these features are generally monitored as a necessary precaution for preventing and/or responding to threats to life or safety.

<u>Student Data Access Notifications -</u> As required by law, the District will notify parents or guardians when technology data is accessed, consistent with Ohio Revised Code Sections 3319.325 - .327.
