- Spirit Nights we will be adding a Rock & Jump trampoline park date as well as a second McTeacher night at McDonald's. This year we will be at the new Riggins Road location for McTeacher night.
- Chiller dates are still being scheduled due to high demand at the ice rinks.
 Rachel is looking into a Jan or March date stay tuned for more info. We will look at increasing the cost for the Chiller event to break even since prices have increased on their end and we haven't increased the cost in several years.

3. Treasurer's Report

- We have been over budget the last few years due to Covid and adjusting to new norms afterwards. Things that had been cut were added back in but the budget was no longer accurately showing those needs. The board met this summer and cut several line items to create more of a balanced budget. We aren't quite there yet but with all the cuts that were made and more fundraisers added, we will reevaluate after this year.
 - Budget cuts that were made were:
 - Class parties parents usually bring in items and do not ask for reimbursements
 - Summer Social moderately attended but cost was high. This
 event will still take place but we will reevaluate what it could look
 like
 - Agreed to create some field day stations in-house and will not go over budget as we have in years past
 - Cut some on staff appreciation
- Artist and Community fund is bringing in a mosaic artist to work with every class and make permanent large mosaic murals for the school
- Washington Gives Back didn't have a budget and it was decided to give the committee a \$200 budget

- This year WGB will focus on the elderly in the community and try to engage with them more and even look at ways to bring them into the school for partnerships with classes
- Suggestion was to gather used Hilliard School Apparel and the PTO could sell it for \$5 and all proceeds would go to the PTO fundraising efforts.
- The 5th graders will be participating in a grade level project to design their own fundraiser and all proceeds will go towards their yard signs, their end of the year party as well as an item/gift to give back to the school.
- Motion made by Nikki Kilbane to approve the budget
 - First: Pauline Puttman
 - Second: Stacey Glatz
 - All were in favor/ no one opposed, the motion was approved.

4. PTO Mission Statement
